Does everything slightly above average, but nothing at an elite level. He is not considered a true dual threat, but is a very capable runner when asked to do so or when needed in scramble scenarios. Playing in a simplified offensive system at Ole Miss helped to cover up some deficiencies as a processor, but he has plenty of tools that can be developed at the next level. It's difficult to picture him as more than a perennial backup, but if drafted to the right system he could pro∨ide a solid fantasy floor and earn a chance to be a long term NFL starter (a similar trajectory to Bo Nix).



Luther Burden is a powerful slot receiver with excellent YAC ability. He plays with tenacity and is difficult to bring down in the open field, leading the FBS in missed tackles forced. His build and play strength makes him an effective blocker.

Burden does not have elite burst or quickness. He saw a lot of manufactured touches at Mizzou and didn't have an elaborate route tree. He tends to round his routes off and I don't see him as a great separator. Burden has some of the strongest hands in this class and has the versatility to be used in a number of roles at the NFL level.



It's hard to come up with any major red flags when watching Higgins' tape. He's your prototypical X receiver with the size and strength to win on the boundaries, especially at the catch point. Higgins has an uncanny ability to box out smaller DBs and high-point the football. He displays excellent body control and spatial awareness along the sidelines and in the endzone.

Higgins won't blow you away with his explosiveness or speed. He's an an average separator but doesn't need a ton of space to win. Higgins has the build and skill set to be a reliable WR2 at the NFL level in the right situation.

Player Profile

Etienne is a reliable and productive between-the-tackles runner with good contact balance. His downhill running style and low pad level allow him to pick up yards after contact and finish runs strongly at the second level. He possesses great short-area quickness and good initial burst which creates a mismatch with linebackers, but lacks the long speed to be a true breakaway runner. He is very comfortable catching the ball out of the backfield and downfield but needs some improvement with both route tree and ability to get separation.

Gadsden is a converted tight end, originally playing wide receiver his freshman year for Syracuse. He's a highly athletic, lanky pass catcher with a full route tree and a natural ability to adjust to poorly thrown passes. Gadsden came into the Shrine Bowl bigger than expected, at 247 lbs, but his normal playing weight is likely thinner than this. Gadsden lacks some play strength after the catch, and while he's a polished route runner, he isn't very explosive out of his breaks. He puts in good effort as a run and pass blocker but can stand too upright and lose leverage at times. Gadsden's skillset is one that is extremely fantasy friendly – he's a vertical threat with excellent ball skills and a large catch radius.
